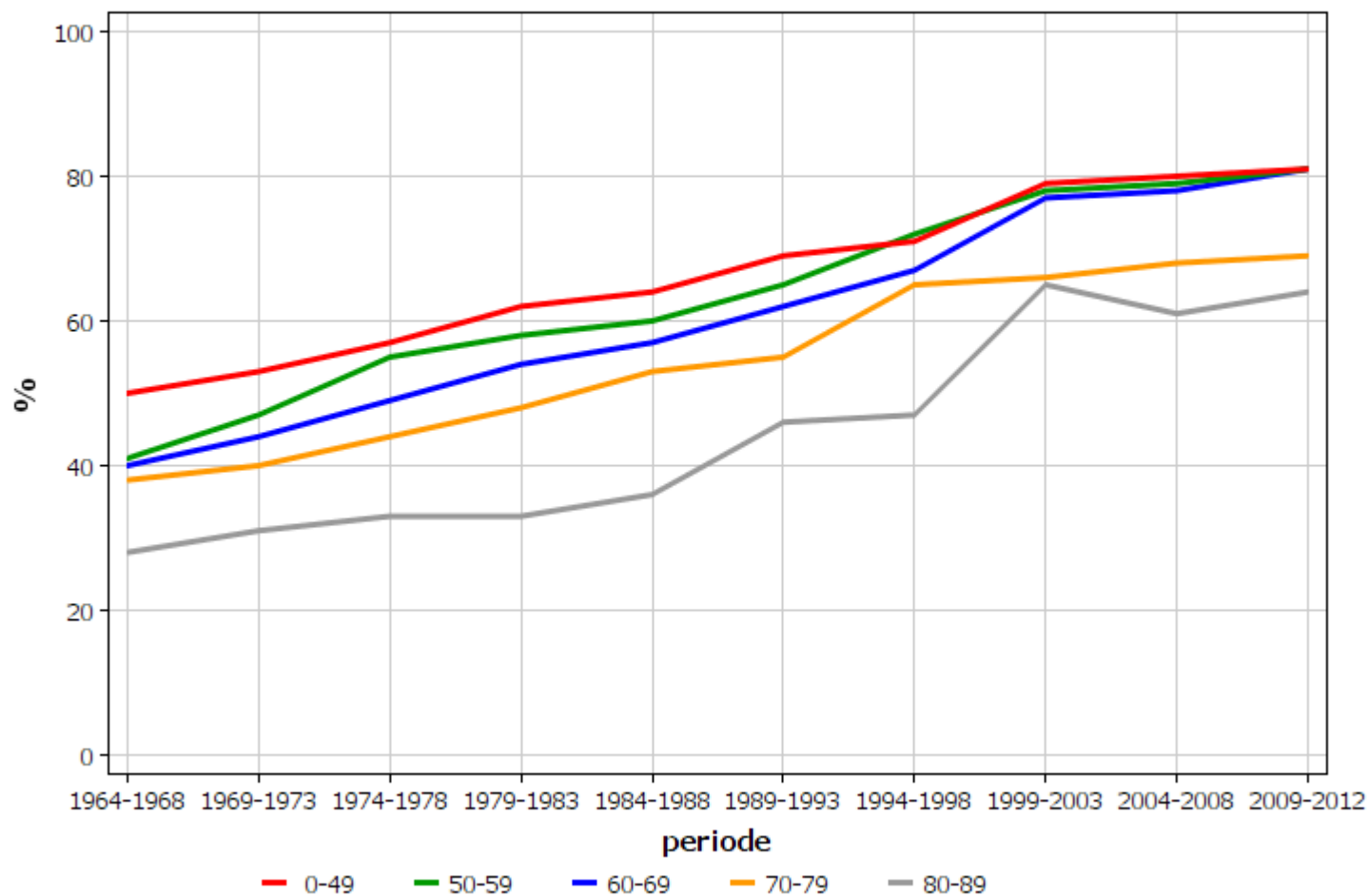




Follow-up after breast cancer treatment in the elderly

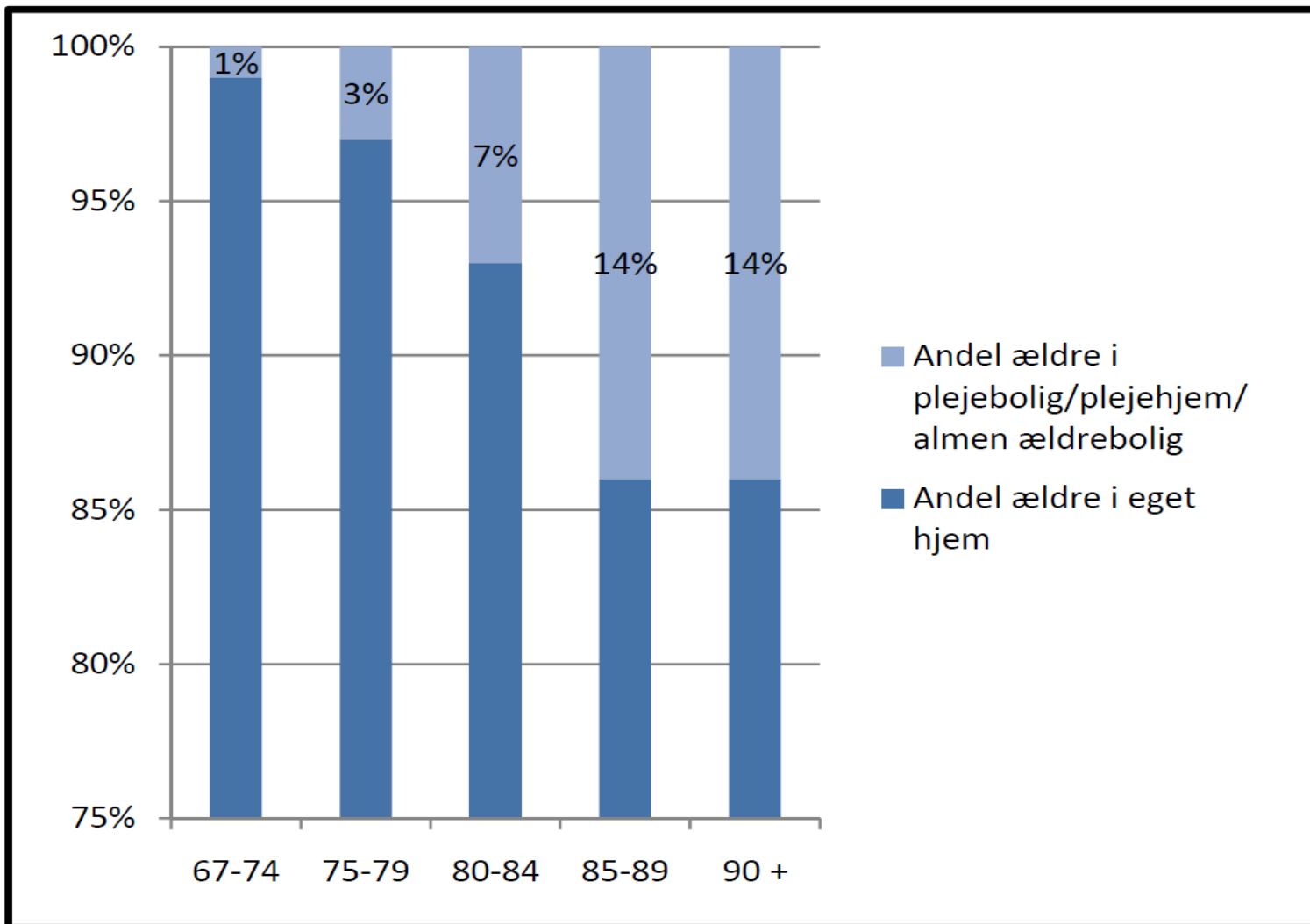

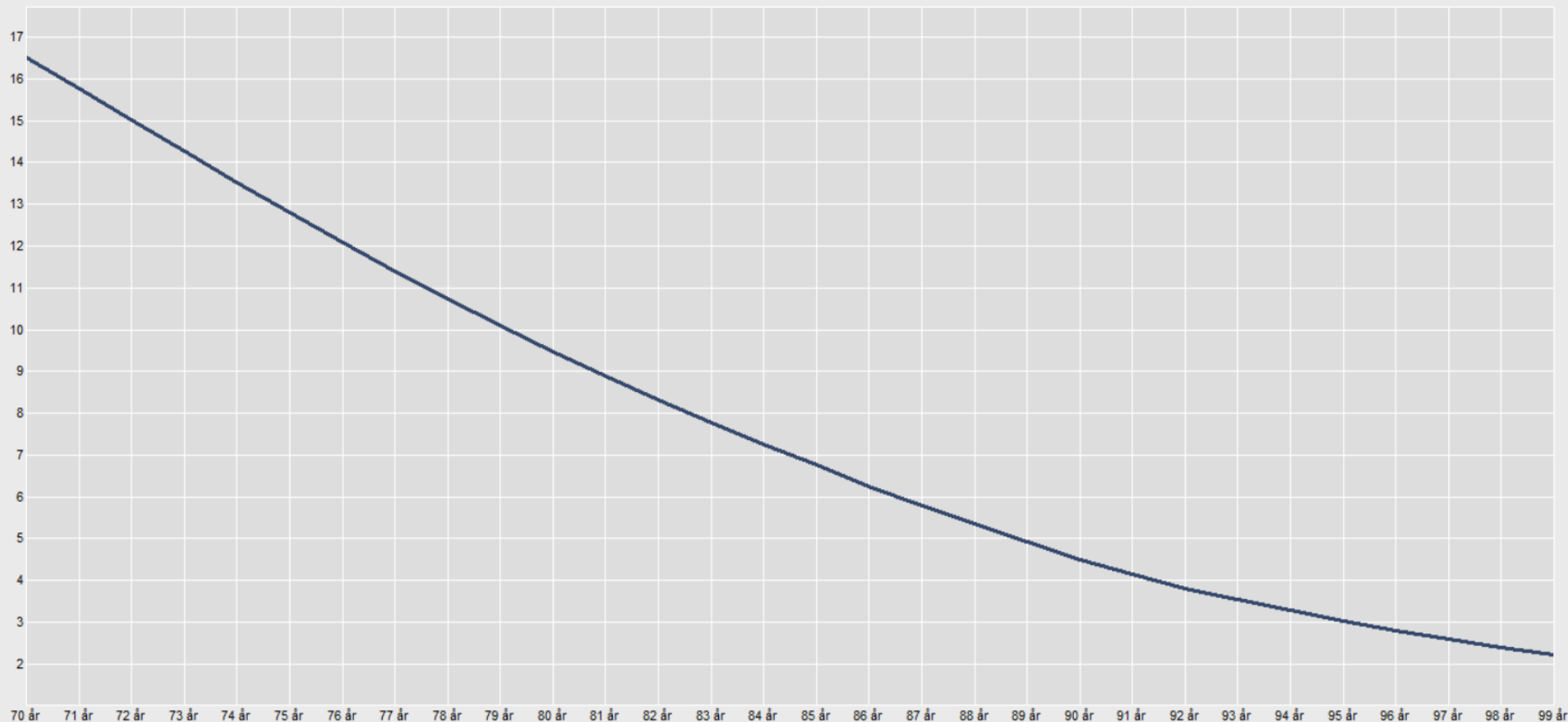
- At what age is the likelihood even of living at home or living in a nursery home?

Danish women have:

- 17,5 years life expectancy at the age of 70 year
- 9,5 years life expectancy at the age of 80 year
- 7 years life expectancy at the age of 85 year
- 4,5 years life expectancy at the age of 90 year

Mammography screening

- Every second year until the age of 80
- Clinical evaluation one year after surgery in order to evaluate side effects of treatment and ensure referral to relevant treatment – in line with what we will offer younger women
