HANDS-ON COURSE FOR ORAL AND MAXILLOFACIAL SURGEONS AND ORTHODONTISTS

The aim of this three-day course is to provide an update on orthognathic surgical treatment of patients with growth deviations of the facial skeleton.

The course provides a comprehensive discussion of patient visitation, diagnosis, treatment planning and orthodontic & surgical procedures. It includes traditional techniques as well as newer trends such as surgery first, use of patient specific guides and spacers, and orthodontic clear aligners.

The course focuses on the importance of a close collaboration and understanding between the oral and maxillofacial surgeon and the orthodontist in these treatments.

The maximum number of participants is limited to 12 to ensure optimal conditions for dialogue and demonstrations.

THE COURSE INCLUDES

Surgical demonstrations (hands-on) on orthognathic surgical patients including conventional orthognathic surgery and distraction osteogenesis (5-6 patients)

Chairside demonstration on patients during different stages of treatment in our in-house orthodontic clinic

Orthodontic surgical planning sessions including 3D virtual planning

Visitation of patients referred for orthognathic surgical treatment

Lectures on surgical techniques, orthodontic planning, distraction osteogenesis, TMJ replacement, surgery first, complications, orthodontic clear aligner and more...
2-4 hours each afternoon.

Day 1 includes a welcome reception 17.00-18.00

Day 2 includes dinner at a restaurant in Aarhus

Price for the course is EUR 1500

A discount of 25% is given when an orthodontist and a surgeon register together (i.e. EUR 1125 per person)
